Three Precision Points That Drive the Outcome

PRECISION 01

Test Cultural Alignment Early

70% of failed integrations cite cultural clash as the primary driver. Treat culture diligence with the same rigor as financial modeling—before Day 1.

PRECISION 02

Model Attrition Risk

Critical talent loss within the first six months can erode up to one-third of expected synergies. Identify linchpin roles and build retention strategy early.
